

## MONTANA'S POET LAUREATE NOMINATION 2025-2027

The Montana Poet Laureate program recognizes and honors a citizen poet of exceptional talent and accomplishment. The Poet Laureate encourages appreciation of poetry and literary life in Montana. This position was created by the state legislature in 2005.

The Poet Laureate is chosen on the basis of three criteria:

- Artistic excellence and achievement
- Ongoing contributions to the cultural community
- Worthiness of statewide recognition

To be eligible, the poet must currently reside in Montana, and either have been a resident for at least three years, or be able to demonstrate a deep connection to Montana. Montana Arts Council members, staff, or their immediate family or household are not eligible.

The Montana Arts Council will be accepting nominations until **Monday, June 30, 2025** at 11:59 pm MDT. Following your nomination, the poet will have the opportunity to accept or decline consideration. The Montana Arts Council will present three recommendations to the Governor, as outlined in Montana Code Annotated 2-15-242.
